Would you like to adopt a tree? You can for £30, payable on ParentPay. Your tree will be part of the wider outdoor Forest School area.

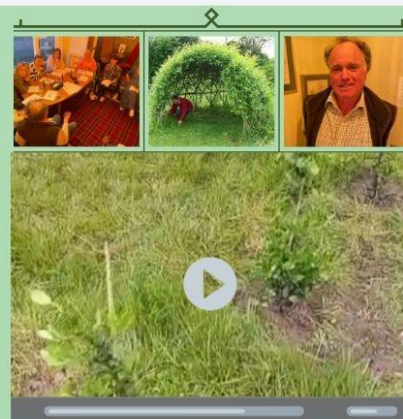


## “A LARDER FOR WILDLIFE”
