Spinney Tales- Crossing the Road Safely



I'm sure you will all have heard about 'The Spinney Tales', which we sometimes read in assembly.



Last term, we listened to a Spinney Tale about road safety. As part of this story, the children learnt about; how to cross a road safely and about the markings on the road and why we have them.

Over the past term, we have had the mud on the road markings cleared, so that drivers can see where it is safe to park. Our Mini Cops have also been out

with the local PCSO to remind drivers where it is safe to park. However, some of the children who walk to school have been worried that drivers are still parking on the single yellow lines and the zig zags before and after school and it is making it
