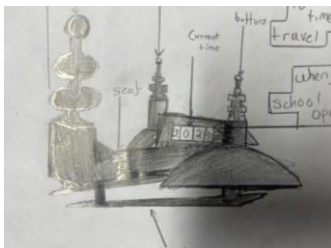
Dear Tattenhall Park families,
