Curriculum

Our curriculum has been developed and adapted to meet the needs of our growing school. Each of the four phases has a two-year rolling programme which embraces the demands of the National Curriculum and offers exciting and stimulating learning opportunities which engage the children. We are fortunate to have a beautiful outdoor space: netball court, a large field with a football pitch, courtyard, trim trail and a newly developed outside area for early years.



Extra Curriculum

We offer a broad range of extra-curricular opportunities which include sports, cooking, computing, science, singing. We also offer Residential opportunities in Years 2 (Delamere), 4 (Colomendy) and 6 (Lake District)





Early Years

Our Early Years department has been designed to meet the needs of our youngest children and open their eyes to the magic of learning. The classrooms and large outside area have their own toilets and are set up to meet the needs of a child-centred curriculum. Staff reflect on children's needs and areas of interest and adapt the curriculum and environment accordingly. The early year's team at Tattenhall Park Primary School consists of experienced teachers and teaching assistants who are skilled in early years teaching. They understand the needs of the young children and how best to create an environment to enable a love of learning. Communication and language development, personal, social and emotional development as well as physical development are all prime areas that are studied in the early year's curriculum. Other subject areas include literacy (including Read, Write, Inc Phonics), mathematics, the world and expressive arts and design.





Before and After School Care



TASC- After School Club

We have our own before and after school club which is open from 7.45am-8.45am before school and from 3.15 until 6pm in the evening. It is run by our dedicated staff team, operating in our joint school and community space. At Tattenhall Around School Care (TASC), our very friendly and experienced staff are here to provide a safe, secure and relaxed environment, creating a home away from home for your child.

We have a whole host of fun and exciting activities including outdoor sports and games, arts and crafts, group baking, board games, sewing and knitting, timed and supervised computer gaming, dressing up and much, much more.

The children are encouraged to participate in the activities as much or as little as they wish. We also have quiet corners where the children can read or have quiet play.

We also provide a good healthy breakfast to start the day and a light snack in the afternoon.
